WHAT INTERNSHIP CANDIDATES NEED TO KNOW

Qualifications for Application

- § Currently enrolled in a counseling program (or have completed a counseling program)
- § Completed a Practicum Experience (supervised clinical training) **Required
- § Completed or is concurrently enrolled in a Multicultural/Diversity course *Preferred
- § Effectively articulate how an internship experience at the ECS relates to his/her career goals
- § Demonstrate the interpersonal abilities, communication skills, and aptitude to be an effective counselor (Note: Interview will include a brief counseling role-play)
- § Superb command of the English language

Hours and Activities

During the fall and spring semesters, the practicum schedule per week includes:

- § 10-12 hours for counseling (more hours may be negotiable on an individual basis)
- § 1 hour for individual supervision meeting
- § 1 hour on internship project

TOTAL hours per week = 14

During the summer semesters, the practicum schedule per week includes:

- § 8-10 hours for counseling (more hours may be negotiable on an individual basis)
- § 1 hour for individual supervision meeting
- § 1 hour on internship project

TOTAL hours per week = 12
