



# ***SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION 2009-2010***

The Student Support Services Project at Eastfield College will disburse grant aid through the Financial Aid Office to a limited number of SSS Participants based in part on the highest amount of unmet financial aid need, and participation in the program.

Interested students must complete a TRiO/SSS scholarship application and meet the following requirements:

- Have been awarded a Federal Pell grant for the 2009-2010 academic year
- Have an Unmet Financial Aid Need
- Be in compliance with the DCCCD Financial Aid Satisfactory Academic Progress Policy for the semester the application is completed.
- Have a minimum 2.0 GPA
- Be enrolled in a minimum of six (6) credit hours at Eastfield College
- Have an active degree plan on file in the Admissions Office
- Have an active DCCCD netmail account.
- Participate in at least four different TRiO/SSS activities within the semester you are applying. The student must participate in one of each of the four following categories (Cultural Enrichment, Workshops, Transfer Trips and Tuesdays With TRiO.) Tutoring and Academic Advising will not be considered for the scholarships. **Students are responsible for attaching activity vouchers with application as proof of participation.**
- All applications should be complete. Incomplete applications will not be processed.

**November 20, 2009 for Fall 2009 / April 16, 2010 for Spring 2010**
