All winners of the competition will be announced. All of the winning entries will be published in the two student arts and literary journals – poetry and fiction in *The Alternative*, essay and one-act play in *The Eclectic*. First place entries will be submitted to the DCCCD competition, hosted by Cedar Valley College. First place DCCCD entries will be submitted to the national competition, hosted by Santa Fe College in Gainesville, Florida.

General Eligibility

Contestant must be a **Fall 2011 or Spring 2012** student enrolled for credit in Eastfield College. Campus coordinator must verify academic enrollment. Entries must be **original works** written during the student's enrollment in credit courses at the college.

Entry Requirements

I. Enrollment Verification:

Printout of Fall 2011 and/or Spring 2012 class schedule

II. Entries must be submitted in TWO forms:

1. **PRINTED:** Typed hard copy, double-spaced on 8.5 x 11 inch white paper with your name/contact information.
2. **DIGITAL:** An electronic copy submitted via attached Word file with email message. Email should contain only the entry files.

A cover page for each entry must include:

- Author's name
- Home address and phone number
- Institution: Eastfield College
- Title of entry
- Author's ID# AND EFC & genre: for example, EFC-poem, EFC-essay, EFC-play, or EFC-fiction

Include in upper right corner of each entry page:

- Title of entry
- Author's ID# AND EFC & genre: for example, EFC-poem, EFC-essay, EFC-play, or EFC-fiction
- Page number

Maximum Length Requirements:

- Poem **must not** exceed 67 lines.
- Personal essay **must not** exceed 2,000 words.
- One-Act play **must not** exceed 3,000 words, including stage directions/production notes.
- Fiction **must not** exceed 3,000 words

Judging

In each category, the judge is a faculty member. Judges' decisions are final.
